and white lights. VIP pass-holders
enjoyed a photo-op with the giant
snowman, spun "Turny" the prize
wheel, created a personalized
snowflake pin and decorated a
snowflake frame for the photo.
Approximately 270 people attended
the Winter Wonderland party
featuring a puppet version of The
Boy Who Cried Wolf, a raffle, snacks
and a book sale by the Friends!

Parents were most appreciative of the program which provided fun motivation for their kids to read over the holidays. This was our initial winter reading event and it was a terrific success.
